

# #TAKE5CAYMAN CHALLENGE

## Instructions:

- Spend 5 minutes (or more if you'd like) collecting trash and cleaning up the environment. Your clean-up can take place on land or in the sea. It can be a coastal area, [protected area](#), public space or simply your own neighbourhood.
- Take a photo/video of the trash you have collected and upload it to Instagram or Facebook using the hashtag **#Take5Cayman** and tag the DOE.
- Once we like your photo you know you have been entered into our random draw to win a Discover Scuba gift certificate from one of our 5 awesome dive partners!
- We encourage you to do as many 5-minute clean-ups as you can however you will receive only one entry per person. ***Unless you include the following...***
  - 1 additional entry (2 entries total) for uploading a second photo showing you *\*appropriately disposing of your trash*. Remember to tag the DOE in your photo or video.
  - And a second additional entry (3 entries total) for uploading a second (or third) photo/video of you sorting and recycling your 5-minute clean up collected trash. Remember to tag the DOE in your photo or video.

## How to appropriately dispose of your trash:

The difference between appropriately disposing of your trash and recycling it is that you could “appropriately” dispose of your trash by placing it in the nearest DEH skip/bin earning an additional entry into the competition OR you can sort your trash and take it for recycling to the nearest recycling depot, e.g. the supermarkets. For guidance on what can be recycled and where please see below.

- The DOE has a number of fishing line recycling bins placed throughout the islands. Click [here](#) to view locations in Grand Cayman and [here](#) to view locations in Cayman Brac and Little Cayman. Please note only fishing line should be placed in these bins.
- The following materials are recycled by DEH: Aluminum cans, batteries (lead and household), contaminated oil, hazardous materials, scrap metals / derelict vehicles, used cooking oil and used motor oil. For more details and recycling locations please visit the [DEH website](#).
- There are recycling bins for plastics, paper, cardboard, glass, metal containers, aluminum foil and tin cans at most supermarkets.
